Passage Study Guide - Acts 18:24-19:10

- 1. What was encouraging about how the church of Ephesus engaged with Apollos in v24-28?
- 2. Consider v27-28 and 1 Corinthians 3:4-6. What was the outcome of the church's discipleship of Apollos?
- 3. Consider the locations of Corinth and Ephesus. Why did Paul decide to return and stay in Ephesus for two years? What was strategic about that decision and what was the outcome?
- 4. How did Paul build up the faith of the disciples in Ephesus and what did it reveal about his attitude towards building up the church?
- 5. The passage we are studying today is characterized by gospel discipleship and partnership. Consider Romans 1:11-12, 1 Thessalonians 2:7-12. Brainstorm as a group: what does it look like to disciple one another?
- 6. What are some challenges that prevent us from being involved in discipling relationships in the church?
- 7. Read Ephesians 4:1-16. How do the person and work of Christ characterize the way we ought to relate with each other in the church?
- 8. Share with one another how Jesus has used certain discipling or personal relationships to help you grow in the gospel.
- 9. Think about the challenges that we have shared in Q6, and consider how the passage in Ephesians 4:1-16 and the testimonies shared can help us to engage these challenges. Then, individually or in pairs, consider prayerfully how Jesus is guiding us to intentionally walk with some people in our CGs or church community.
